DESCRIPTION

Spend the day learning how to draw stunning seasonal botanical works using coloured pencils. A step-by-step project such as a decorative gourd or pumpkin will be the focus of the day. Coloured pencils are easy to use and convenient to store and replace, making them an ideal medium for both beginning students and experienced artists. The drawing process will be discussed in detail and techniques such as burnishing and layering, along with accurate colour matching, tonal rendering and composition will help students master this rewarding medium.

Materials

- Spiral-bound sketchbook for class exercises
- 1 Peterboro Cold Pressed #79 Illustration Board (20 x 15 inches)
OR – 1 Hot Pressed Watercolour Art Board (20 x 15 inches)
- 1 sheet graphite transfer paper
- Drawing pencils (graphite) 2H, H
- Coloured pencil sharpener
- Kneaded eraser
- Mono Zero (Tombow) 2.3 mm round tip eraser
- Selection of blending stumps, tortillons and soft makeup brush
